

Lesson Plan – Google Translate

Topic: Lesson 2 – Google Translate	Date
Introduction Google Translate is an app that you can use to communicate with someone who speaks a different language than you. Have you ever had difficulty communicating with a neighbor that speaks a different language than you? Or how about a staff member at the community? How about a letter or bill that you’ve received but you need help translating it? Google Translate can help!	
Student Learning Goal <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Understand what Google Translate is and how it can help you communicate2. Have a conversation (can be short!) with a neighbor, friend, or staff member who speaks another language

-Practice Together: <i>Let’s practice communicating in a different language!</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Say to your device, “Hey Google, help me speak English”2. Google translate will open up3. Tap the microphone to speak in your native language, “Hi, my name is [NAME].”4. Wait for sentence to translate5. Tap the microphone to speak in your native language, “Hi, my name is [NAME]. What do you like to do in your free time?”6. Wait for sentence to translate.
